A general-assignment reporter with the *Youngstown Vindicator* and author, Barron, 50, was originally diagnosed with autism at age 4. Although Barron coped academically, school was miserable for him socially. Gradually, he figured out how to function effectively in society, and began to share his story publicly first through a book he and his mother wrote called **There's a Boy in Here: Emerging From the Bonds of Autism**. Later, he and Temple Grandin, a college professor with autism, co-wrote **Unwritten Rules of Social Relationships: Decoding Social Mysteries Through the Unique Perspectives of Autism**. The writing experience led Barron to get a journalism degree and his job.
