Although Barron coped academically, school was miserable for him socially. Gradually, he figured out how to function effectively in society, and began to share his story publicly first through a book he and his mother wrote called **There's a Boy in Here: Emerging From the Bonds of Autism**. Later, he and Temple Grandin, a college professor with autism, co-wrote **Unwritten Rules of Social Relationships: Decoding Social Mysteries Through the Unique Perspectives of Autism**. The writing experience led Barron to get a journalism degree and his job.
