Understanding Your Child's Assessment: What it Means for You & Your Child

Dr. Frazier will explain how to gain competency in the boundaries of each of the domains of assessment and discuss the meaning of measurements within each domain. He will also help us understand how major instruments are interpreted and what these interpretations might mean for our children. Finally, he will discuss examples of realistic cases and how the assessment can enhance educational planning.

Thomas W. Frazier, Ph.D., is a Staff Member with Cleveland Clinic Children's Hospital Center for Autism and Center for Pediatric Behavioral Health. He also is jointly appointed in the Genomic Medicine Institute and an Assistant Professor in the Lerner College of Medicine. He has published more than 30 papers and given more than 80 conference presentations on autism, ADHD, pediatric bipolar disorder, and other aspects of clinical assessment. His primary clinical interest includes the assessment and behavioral treatment of individuals with autism spectrum disorder. However, Dr. Frazier also specializes in the assessment and differentiation of pediatric bipolar disorder, ADHD, and other disruptive behavior disorders in his clinical practice.
