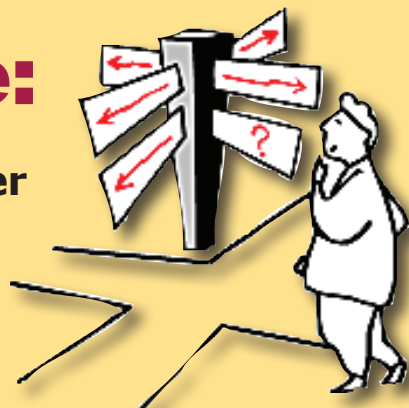


Making the right choice:
