He was a member of the 1983 National Championship Miami Hurricanes, worked in the transportation field (International Air and Ocean Freight) for 24 years before leaving to start his own Cleveland-based company called “Johnnyville Woods.” He has raised 5 kids: Four boys and a girl. Amongst his children, two graduated from Ohio State University, one from Johns Hopkins University, and one from Wake Forest University.

Johnny's son with Autism, who is now 25 years old, graduated from Johns Hopkins University with a degree in Biomedical Engineering and went on to work at Google. Johnny's talk will be about his family's experience in raising a son with special needs, who not only graduated from High School two years early, but went ahead to college and independent living.
