



Soccer4All Registration Information

Registration is now underway for the Fall 2018 season of Soccer4All. Soccer4All is the Hudson United Soccer Club's (HUSC) program for children with physical and/or developmental disabilities. The program is open to any child, 4-25 years old, with a developmental delay or disability including but not limited to: A.D.D./A.D.H.D, Autism, Hearing Impaired, Sight Impaired, Cerebral Palsy, Traumatic Brain Injury, Cystic Fibrosis, Down Syndrome, Multiple Sclerosis, Muscular Dystrophy, Seizure Disorder and Spina Bifida. Players do not need to be Hudson residents.

The Soccer4All program has three primary goals: 1) Get active; 2) Make friends; and 3) Have fun! It also gives parents an opportunity to enjoy watching their children as well as develop friendships themselves.

Soccer4All utilizes many young volunteers called soccer buddies. Buddies are middle and high school players from HUSC's other programs who assist the Soccer4All players and coaches. In many cases, players are paired up one-on-one with a buddy to offer individualized direction and support.

Who: Boys and girls 4-25 years old with physical and/or mental disabilities

Where: Barlow Farm Park in Hudson

When: Every Saturday from 11:00 to 12:00 noon. Sessions begin September 8 and end on October 13. The first half hour each week is practice time followed by a half-hour game.

Cost: Registration fee is \$25 and includes a jersey, soccer ball (if needed), and a participation award and picnic at the end of the season.
